Positions available with our Volunteer Program:

- **Information Desk Attendant** - Greet visitors, share information about the refuge and community, answer phones, perform simple clerical duties.
- **Bookstore Clerk** - Ring up sales, stock shelves, organize inventory, answer the phone and customer questions.
- **Teacher/Naturalist** - Assist environmental education staff to develop and lead programs and special projects for school groups and educators. Give presentations to the general public at the refuge, local schools or at special events. Share your interest, enthusiasm and dedication to connect students with nature!
- **Special Events Assistant** - Help to plan, advertise and execute special events and interpretive programs for the public. Create and staff a booth at outreach events such as fairs and open houses.
- **Refuge Tour Guide** - Lead refuge tours for the public April through August, sharing information about the refuge and looking at birds. What could be more fun?
- **Refuge Maintenance Steward** - Fill brochure boxes, pick up litter, assist refuge maintenance staff. Help keep the refuge looking beautiful!
- **Newsletter Staff** - Assist Friends of the Bear River Refuge with writing and layout of their newsletter.
- **Photographer** - Shoot high quality digital photographs of birds, habitat and visitors enjoying the refuge for promotion, outreach, displays and reports.
